

**DISTRICT 34 IMMUNIZATIONS REQUIRED
(Chapter 122, Section 27-8, Illinois School Code)**

HEPATITIS B

Early Childhood

- Series of 3 doses must be started prior to school entrance

Fifth Grade

- Must show evidence of having received 3 doses of vaccine

D.P.T. (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Whooping Cough)

Kindergarten or First Grade

- Four or more doses, the last being a booster received prior to school entrance, on or after 4th birthday

Six Years or Older

- Three or more doses, the last being a booster received prior to school entrance, on or after 4th birthday

*Individual doses in the series must have been received no less than six weeks apart.

POLIO

Kindergarten or First Grade

- Three or more doses, the last being a booster received prior to school entrance, on or after the 4th birthday

Six Years or Older

- Three or more doses, the last being received prior to school entrance, on or after 4th birthday

*Individual doses in the series must have been received no less than six weeks apart.

MEASLES

Kindergarten or First Grade

- Two doses, the first administered no earlier than 12 months of age, the second no less than one month later.

RUBELLA

(Required even if child has had the disease)

Kindergarten or First Grade

- Has received vaccine at one year of age or later

Six Years of Age or Older

- Has received rubella vaccine at one year of age or later

MUMPS

Kindergarten and older

- Has received mumps vaccine at one year of age or later

HAEMOPHILUS INFLUENZAE

Early Childhood

- One HIB vaccination on or after 15 months of age

CHICKEN POX

Early Childhood through 8th Grade

- Progressive requirement to add grades until 2014
