



DISTRICT 34 IMMUNIZATIONS REQUIRED
(Chapter 122, Section 27-8, Illinois School Code)

HEPATITIS B

Early Childhood

- Series of 3 doses must be completed prior to school entrance.

Sixth Grade

- Must show evidence of having received 3 doses of vaccine.

D.P.T. (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Whooping Cough)

Kindergarten and Older

- Four or more doses, the last being a booster received prior to school entrance, on or after 4th birthday
*Individual doses in the series must have been received no less than four weeks apart.

Sixth Grade

- Any child entering sixth grade shall show proof of receiving one dose of Tdap (defined as tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) vaccine regardless of the interval since the DTaP, DT or Td dose.

POLIO

Early Childhood

- Two doses by age 1. One additional dose by second birthday.

Kindergarten or First Grade

- Four or more doses, the last being a booster received prior to school entrance, on or after the 4th birthday.

Second Grade or Older

- Three or more doses, the last being received on or after 4th birthday.

MEASLES

Early Childhood

- 1 dose administered on or after 1st birthday.

Kindergarten and Older

- Two doses, the first administered on or after 1 year old, the second no less than 4 weeks later.

RUBELLA

(Required even if child has had the disease)

Early Childhood

- 1 dose administered on or after 1st birthday.

Kindergarten and Older

- Two doses, the first administered on or after 1 year old, the second no less than 4 weeks later.



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MUMPS

Early Childhood

- 1 dose administered on or after 1st birthday

Kindergarten and Older

- Two doses, the first administered on or after 1 year old, the second no less than 4 weeks later.

HAEMOPHILUS INFLUENZAE

Early Childhood

- One Hib vaccination on or after 15 months of age.

VARICELLA (CHICKEN POX)

Early Childhood

- One vaccination required or proof of disease with letter from physician.

Kindergarten and Older

- Two vaccinations required or proof of disease with letter from physician. Grade 5 only is required to have 1 dose.

PNEUMOCOCCAL (PCV)

Early Childhood

- Four doses required prior to 5 years old.

MENINGOCOCCAL

6th Grade

- One dose required on or after the 10th birthday.

- Parents or legal guardians who are requesting a religious exemption to immunizations or examinations **must** use this form for students entering kindergarten, sixth or ninth grades.
- A separate form must be used for **each child** with a religious exemption enrolled
- This form may not be used for exemptions from immunizations and/or examination for personal or philosophical reasons. Illinois law does not allow for such exemptions.
