Residency Verification 2020-21 School Year

In order to attend Glenview School District 34 on a tuition-free basis, a student is required to physically reside within the boundaries of the school district on a permanent basis. Verification applies to students new to District 34, students whose families have moved within the district during the previous school year, those entering early childhood, kindergarten, 3rd grade, 6th grade, families with a lease that expired during the previous school year, and other families as determined by the district.

To ensure that your child's enrollment is not delayed, residency documents are due by May 22nd.

Required documents are listed on the following page. All families must submit the required documents and affirmation of legal residency. Only one set of documents per family is necessary, if you receive multiple copies, please discard all but one.

In order for a document to be valid, it must:

- Be current as of the first day of school or as of the current month
- Clearly show a name and address (service address for utility bills)

If information received at the time of registration does not satisfactorily confirm residency, District 34 may take additional steps to verify residency, including but not limited to any or all of the following steps:

- Request additional documentation verifying residency
- Make a personal home visit(s)

If District 34 determines that the parent/guardian is not a resident of the district, the parent/guardian will be:

- Notified of the student's immediate removal from school, subject to appeal procedures outlined in 105 ILCS 5/10-20.12b of the Illinois School Code
- The district may determine that the parent/guardian will be charged tuition fees per student per day of attendance for the entire duration of the student's attendance at the district during which time the student was not a resident. The district may take legal action against the parent/guardian to enforce collection.

Documentation should not have expired prior to the first day of school. Additional documentation may be requested as deemed necessary on a case-by-case basis.
