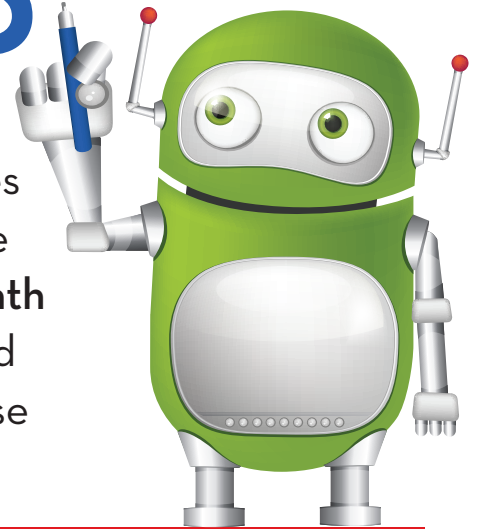

Information and Consent

Age Recommendations and Lunch: If your child's age is just under or over 8 to 12, please contact us at 847-982-9888 for special consideration. Lunch is not provided. Students should bring their own lunch and snacks. Full-day programs will break for lunch at noon. Students registered for a half-day morning and afternoon program on the same day will be supervised by a staff member during the lunch hour between programs.

Tuition and Fees: Payment is due at the time of registration. Each registration form must include a \$9 registration fee.

Cancellation/Refunds: Full tuition will be refunded (minus the \$9 registration fee) if notification is received at least five business days prior to the first class session. A \$15 fee will be charged for cancellations. No refunds will be issued for requests received less than five business days before the start of class. If Oakton cancels a program, registrants receive a full refund.
